JOB DESCRIPTION

Time Commitment: 1 Year – 1.5 hours per week

Every Week

An actor or storyteller is someone who is dedicated to the mission' of The Chapel and its' Children's Ministry. Using the gifts that God has uniquely gifted you with as an actor, you are responsible to recreate a character from our curriculum. You work with a cast of actors to create a dilemma or situation that needs to be resolved by a Biblical application. As a storyteller you are responsible to teaching the Biblical message from God's Word in a creative way according to our curriculum. You need to be able to act and memorize. This volunteer position will require an audition. It also requires an additional time for rehearsal each week.

After you fill out a ministry volunteer application, you will be paired up with an experienced volunteer who will guide and mentor you while providing on the job training. You may wish to "shadow" a volunteer in many areas of children's ministry until you find the right fit. If your right fit is a worship leader, you will then be assigned to a Service Coordinator who will be your mentor and ensure that you are properly equipped. You must be in the 6th grade or older to serve.
