ELEMENTARY SMALL GROUP LEADER

JOB DESCRIPTION

Time Commitment: 1 Year – 1.5 hours per week

Every Week 1st & 3rd Weeks 2nd & 4th Weeks

An elementary small group leader (SGL) is someone who is dedicated to the missions' of The Chapel and its' Children's Ministry, loves each child in their care, and is responsible for what happens with an assigned small group of children in the classroom. Through a relationship with them, the SGL prepares for and works to create an environment where elementary kids are learning the 3 basic truths of Elementary Chapel Kids. Kids learn to make the wise choice, that they can trust God no matter what, and that they should treat others the way they want to be treated. An elementary SGL is someone who invests in a loving relationship with every child and makes an effort to build a bridge to the family. You will be responsible for preparing and teaching a weekly lesson that is provided to you.

So how do I become an Elementary Small Group Leader?

It's easy! The first step is to fill out a ministry volunteer application. After you are background checked, you will attend an orientation to hear more about Chapel Kids and the specific needs that we have. After the orientation, you will go through training and with the help of a Chapel Kids staff member, determine the age group in which you will best fit and thrive. Because an elementary SGL plays an important role in the first impression many families have of The Chapel, you will be paired up with an experienced volunteer who will guide and direct you while providing on the job training. You may wish to "shadow" a volunteer in many areas of children's ministry until you find the right fit. If your right fit is an elementary SGL, you will then be assigned to a Service Coordinator who will ensure who will ensure that the new elementary SGL is properly equipped. You must be a member.
