JOB DESCRIPTION

Time Commitment: 1 Year – 1.5 hours per week

Every Week 1st & 3rd Weeks 2nd & 4th Weeks

A preschool small group leader (SGL) is someone who is dedicated to the missions' of The Chapel and its' Children's Ministry, loves each child in their care, and is able to handle a fair amount of chaos! Through a relationship with them, the SGL introduces children to their first look at the loving God who made them, loves them and wants to be their friend forever (our 3 basic truths). A Preschool SGL is someone who cares about each family that enters their room and prays for them continually. You will be responsible for preparing and teaching a weekly lesson that is provided to you.

So how do I become a Preschool Small Group Leader?

It's easy! The first step is to fill out a ministry volunteer application. After you are background checked, you will attend an orientation to hear more about Chapel Kids and the specific needs that we have. After the orientation, you will go through training and with the help of a Chapel Kids staff member, determine the age group in which you will best fit and thrive. Because preschool SGL play an important role in the first impression many families have of The Chapel, you will be paired up with an experienced volunteer who will guide and direct you while providing on the job training. You may wish to "shadow" a volunteer in many areas of children's ministry until you find the right fit. If your right fit is a preschool SGL, you will then be assigned to a Service Coordinator who will ensure that the preschool SGL is properly equipped. At The Chapel, we believe there is no greater privilege and responsibility than leading children into relationships with Jesus Christ. It's why we do everything that we do!
